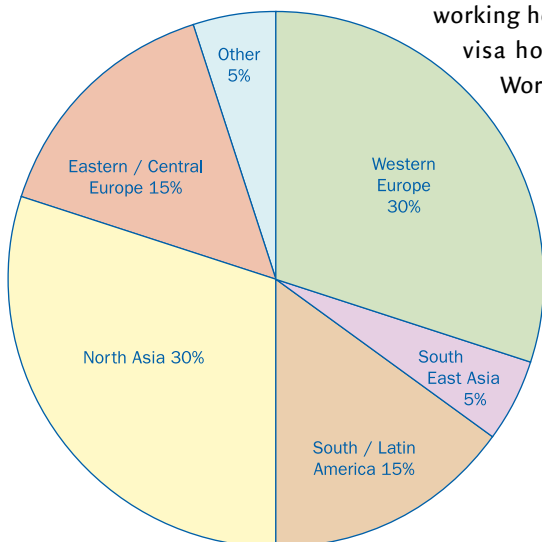

Range of levels

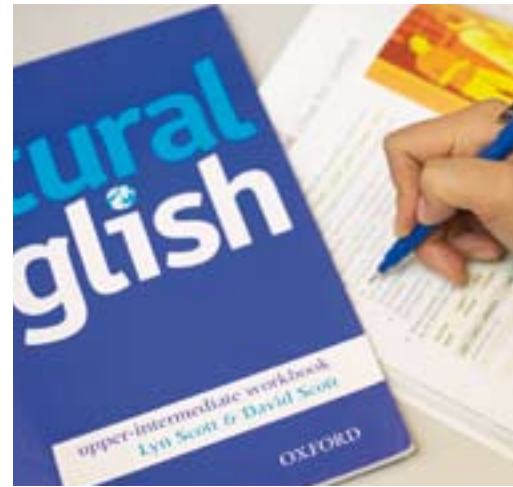
We have a full range of levels from beginners to advanced. On your first day you will complete a placement test and interview. You will then join a class of students who all have very similar needs and strengths.

2. Special Focus Modules

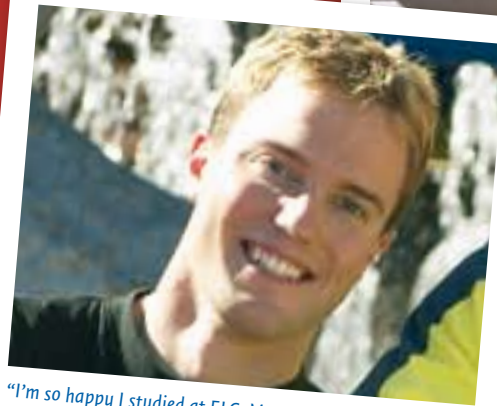
